Responsible for supervising, monitoring, repairing, and attending to park rides, including boarding and securing passengers, starting rides, and ensuring passengers exit safely.

Ride operators work for amusements parks where their main responsibility is the safe operation of a ride or series of rides. They assist guests in operating rides in a safe manner and provide them with training on how to ride safely. They also supervise and monitor rides during the time they are in operation.

This is a physical job. You must be able to do the following:

- The ability to stand for long hours at a time
- The ability to kneel, crouch, lift and bend.
- The ability to see and respond to dangerous situations.
- The ability to work in unpredictible weather: rain, wind, cooler and hot temperatures.
- The ability to wear personal protective gear correctly most of the day.

Perform a variety of cleaning activities such as sweeping, mopping, dusting and polishing

- Ensure all rooms are cared for and inspected according to standards
- Protect equipment and make sure there are no inadequacies
- Notify superiors on any damages, deficits and disturbances
- Deal with reasonable complaints/requests with professionalism and patience
- Check stocking levels of all consumables and replace when appropriate
- Adhere strictly to rules regarding health and safety and be aware of any company-related practices
- Ability to work with little supervision and maintain a high level of performance
- Customer-oriented and friendly
- Prioritization and time management skills
- Working guickly without compromising quality
- Knowledge of English language

 - ·Latch passengers in securely.
 - •Board passengers onto ride.
 - •Explain safety procedures to riders.
 - •Point out evacuation routes.
 - •Operate equipment that starts and shuts down ride.
 - •Entice patrons by describing the actions of the ride.
 - •Ensure passengers are secured safely.
 - •Pull down safety bars, buckle seat belts, or secure harnesses.
 - •Inspect equipment to detect wear and tear.
 - •Stop vehicle and de-board passengers in case of emergencies.
 - •Provide assistance to patrons entering and exiting ride.
 - •Shut down ride if major repairs are needed.
 - •Space rides operated in cars or sections to avoid danger of collisions.
 - •Clean up debris around ride.
 - •Operate music during ride.
 - •Keep an eye on patrons and their movements to ensure they are not in any danger

Skills Required:

Applicants must be trustworthy, friendly, and have a positive attitude! Employees have direct contact with the public and must have good people skills and be able to communicate in a fast-paced work environment. Teamwork and professionalism are very impor-

In each room there are 3 to 4 twin sized beds with mattresses and a shelf and locker above to store your items. Linens and a pillow are provided by Hiawatha. There is a fridge and microwave in the room.

Each student will get their own bed.

If you are a couple and want to live together, you MUST have another person that will agree to live with you before arrival. There must be at least three people living in the room. There is no guarantee that you will be able to room together during your time on program however Hiawatha will do their best to accommodate your request.
