Schedule will vary depending on events taking place in the park.

Most participants will have the opportunity to work 4-6 shifts during the week that are 8-16 hours long and will have 1-3 days off during the week to travel the area or work a second job if they choose. Extra hours may be available in other departments during the week.

Some weeks may have a 5-6 day work week during special events taking place at the park.

Working weekends (Saturday and Sunday) and holiday's is required.

Additional Hours Details:

You will work an average of 32 hours per week over the course of your program. Some weeks may be more, some may be less. 32 hours per week is the average. Due to the nature of our outdoor business some weeks may be less hours.

Position Description:

Ride Operations Team Members are responsible for operating rides but should also be prepared to assist in selling tickets, cleaning and stocking bathrooms, keeping pathways clear of debris, directing traffic and performing a number of other duties throughout the park. All positions require a high level of customer contact and good customer service skills.

Due to the nature of outdoor business Busch Gardens Williamsburg/Water Country USA does not guarantee work hours during periods of bad weather.

Although some weeks may have less than 32 hours per week, you can expect to average 32 hours per week or more over the course of your program.

Due to the outdoor nature of the business, there may be times where you will work less hours if the weather is bad for long periods of time. This is not expected, but is always a possibility. Busch Gardens Williamsburg/Water Country USA will make every possible effort to ensure you meet the "average" 32 hours per week of more over the course of your program. You should expect there will be times where you will be scheduled a larger amount of hours and it is not unusual to be scheduled 40-50+ hours a week at certain times of the year. Extra work hours may be available in other Departments if assistance is needed.

You should plan to work 40 or more hours per week during the month of August.

After Labor Day, the Park is only open on the weekends. Generally you can expect to work approximately 32 hours per week in September. Hours will be available during the days the park is open (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday). Some hours may be avialble on Thursday getting ready for park opening.

The Host Company offers a great program to participants and does their best to provide you with cultural experiences along with your work experience. Examples of some of these activities includes:

- *Trips to museums in Historic Williamsburg

Grooming:
